WOODSTOCK TOWNSHIP CLEAN-UP PROGRAM

At the June 9, 2025 board meeting the Woodstock Township Board voted to have a Clean-Up Program instead of a spring/fall cleanup date, that provides the property owners of Woodstock Township one (1) free Transfer Station Ticket per household. This will allow the Property Owner to take their trash to Lakeshore Recycling Systems (LRS), formerly Modern Waste Systems in Napoleon MI. There is a limited supply of Transfer Station Tickets and they will be first come-first serve. Verification of residence will need to be provided.

*****Ticket expiration date February 26, 2027*****

You will need to pick up the tickets at the Woodstock Township Office during the regular business hours.

Monday 9am–4 pm, Tuesday 8am-4pm, Wednesday & Thursday 8am-1pm, Friday 9am-1pm.

IT IS ILLEGAL TO TRANSPORT AN UNSECURED LOAD. YOUR LOAD MUST BE COVERED PRIOR TO TRANSPORTING IT TO LAKESHORE RECYCLING SYSTEMS. YOU CAN BE TICKETED FOR NOT DOING SO.

You must have a Transfer Ticket with you, or you will be charged for the load and expected to pay at the time of dumping at the site.

Resident must unload everything themselves, or pay \$30 for LRS to unload.

The ticket must have your signature and address on it.

You will have to scale your load both full and empty.

Each ticket is good for one-time use only and is limited to 1,000 pounds. Anything over 1,000 is the property owner's responsibility.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS-Subject to change at LRS discretion.

- ✓ Bagged municipal solid waste (household garbage)
- ✓ Larger items such as Furniture, mattresses, box springs, toys, bicycles, appliances*, home fixtures, and any other items if they are considered non-hazardous and can be safely lifted by two (2) people.
- ✓ Latex Paints-paint must be dried-up in the container (use sawdust, kitty litter, or just leave the lid off until the paint dries and is solid).
- ✓ Large plastic drums or metal burn barrels- NO HOT ASH allowed in barrel.
- ✓ Concrete
- ✓ Metal
- ✓ Yard waste- MUST BE BAGGED.
- ✓ Construction materials.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS- Subject to change at LRS discretion.

- X Liquid waste
- X Hazardous waste
- X Non-latex paints & varnishes
- X Motor oil & solvents
- X Batteries
- X Regulated medical waste
- X Appliances that contain Freon such a refrigerators & air conditioner, etc.
- X Any additional items that are listed by the Michigan DEQ as banned from Michigan Landfills.
- X Tires

***Appliances must have the Freon removed and tagged by a licensed facility before it will be accepted.**
